This applies to all companies that post jobs and/or engage with student clubs, programs, and centers. Failure to abide by these policies may necessitate sanctions for the violating company. Academic Commitments

Students may not miss class, an exam, or academic commitments for interviews, recruiting events, or travel related to those activities. An employer's inflexibility on this issue will be considered a violation of the School's recruiting policy.

Diversity Hiring

Columbia Business School is a proud member of the Consortium as the 21st member school. Please contact the CMC if you would like to dicuss your diversity hiring strategy, including for pre-MBA programs. The CMC partners with student affinity clubs such as Black Business Students Association (BBSA), Hispanic Business Association (HBA), Cluster Q (LGBTQ+), Military in Business Association (MIBA) and Columbia Women in Business (CWiB). We also have relationships with diversity partner organizations such as Management Leadership for Tomorrow (MLT), Toigo, Forté Foundation, and Reaching Out.

While the CMC encourages diversity candidates to engage in early education and networking, students should be given the opportunity to interview along with their peers during the academic year campus timeline. Once a student matriculates at CBS, neither interviews nor offers, including fellowship offers, may be made prior to the earliest offer date.

International Employers

Global offices of U.S. domestic firms, as well as all international companies, will be held to the same recruiter policies and timeline as U.S. employers, unless pre-approved by the CMC.

Formal & Informal Events

All formal and informal events, including those targeting student clubs, must be submitted through COIN for the CMC to ensure a conflict-free calendar. Examples of events include, and are not limited to; on-campus, off-campus, and virtual events, company information sessions, practice area and regional presentations, diversity events, office hours, coffee chats/meetings, social events, invite-only (closed) events, breakfasts, lunches, and dinners, multi-school events, and all other networking events. All events are limited to a one-hour duration.

Summer Semester 2023

January-term and EMBA students are in class over the summer and are available for information sessions and networking events for full-time opportunities.

Fall Semester 2023

Companies are limited to hosting three events (including virtual events) per class year, plus one diversity event.

Events that Fall Under Policy

- Company Information Sessions
- Practice Area Networking Events
- Social Events
- Invite-Only Events

Events Excluded from Policy

- Coffee Chats
- Multi-School & Multi-Firm Events

Individual and small group coffee chats and informational interviews must be cleared through the CMC, and students must not be asked to miss class. It is recommended to follow event date and time guidelines to ensure a student does not have an academic conflict. We encourage companies to be flexible when offering students the opportunity to engage in coffee chats.

Additional Information

Different divisions (e.g., investment banking vs. asset management) or geographic offices within a company may qualify as separate entities for the purpose of this policy, and firms must receive prior approval from the CMC before planning an event.

*Companies may not host events, including informal networking, on blackout dates. No events during the exam period, including multi-school and/or virtual events will be marketed to students.

Tuesday, September 5, 2023 2Y Company Events begin

 Companies may choose to host offcampus events prior to this date as long as they begin no earlier than 6:30pm. Events on or after this date must follow date and time guidelines.

Tuesday, September 26, 2023 1Y Company Events begin

 Company representatives may not interact with 1Y students in any capacity from Monday, August 21 through Monday, September 25, 2023. This includes any continuation of pre-matriculation recruiting activity.

Friday, September 29, 2023 Annual Fall Career Fair (11am-2pm)

 Companies may participate in this event in lieu of holding a standalone event. No other company events may be booked during this time.

Wednesday, November 1, 2023 Small Group Invitation-Onlys begin

Each company may host one small group invitation-only event between November 1 and December 7, 2023. No invitation-only events, formal or informal, inclusive of interview preparation, may take place after this date.


Interview Calendar Notes

- Full-time offers, including those to summer interns, must be held open for at least three weeks from the date of the written offer, and the CMC encourages employers to be flexible about extending this deadline so that students can make a well-considered decision on offers. Offers extended on or after February 16, 2024, must remain open for at least 7 calendar days from receipt of written offer.
- Students cannot be required to indicate acceptance of an offer until a written communication is received.
- Interviews may not take place during blackout dates.

- Students cannot be required to indicate acceptance of an offer until a written communication is received.
- Interviews may not take place during blackout dates.

Full-Time Interviews

The CMC will be pleased to host on-campus interviews for interviews taking place **Tuesday**, **September 5**, **2023**, or later.

- Companies should offer an alternate date and time for second-round interviews for students with scheduling conflicts.
- Interviews may not take place during blackout dates.
- Full-time offers, including those to summer interns, must be held open for three weeks from the date of the written offer.
- The fundamental terms of an offer must remain unchanged until the expiration date, although incentives encouraging students to commit before the deadline are permitted, so long as incentives are small relative to the overall value of the offer and the incentive is aligned with the spirit of the recruiting processes (e.g., group-specific offers which may convert to generalist offers).

Internship Interviews

No interviews or offers are permitted between August 21, 2023 and January 3, 2024. Exceptions may be allowed for certain international and regional offices outside of New York tri-state area, only with prior written approval from the CMC.

The CMC will be pleased to host on-campus interviews starting January 3.

Application deadlines may not occur before Monday, November 27, 2023.

- Internship interviews for all industries begin **Wednesday**, **January 3**, **2024**. Second round internship interviews for investment banking begin **Tuesday**, **January 9**, **2024**.
- Offers for investment banking internships may not be extended before 5 PM EST on Friday, January 12, 2024.
- Offers for industries outside of investment banking may be extended anytime after the completion of first-round interviews.
- Companies should offer an alternate date and time for second-round interviews for students with scheduling conflicts.
- Interviews may not take place during blackout dates, or prior to January 3 without written approval.
- All summer internship offers in all industries must remain open until **Friday**, **February 2, 2024**, or for three weeks of receipt of written offer, whichever is later.
- Offers extended on or after February 16, 2024 must remain open for at least seven calendar days from receipt of written offer.
