

## 1. What is this Community Giveback Project? (Why and How...)

We received input asking for ways to participate in something that gives back to the community (hence the rather literal name "Community Giveback Project"!). Our goal is participation – 100%, ideally! It would be great if EVERYONE gave a little something – money or blood.

By partnering with Hawai'i Pacific Health's annual giving campaign and highlighting organizations such as Blood Bank of Hawai'i, Hawai'i Community Foundation - COVID-19 Resilience Fund, and Aloha United Way, we hope to make the biggest impact for our community where it's needed most, at the point of care and at home.

### 2. Is it a competition?

Yes, we've grouped all Hawai'i Health Partners' provider members into teams for a friendly competition that begins <u>now</u> and culminates at the end of the virtual annual meeting on Saturday, November 7<sup>th</sup>.

During that time, teams will be ranked separately based on both % participation and total dollars raised. View your team's rankings on the Whova <u>web browser application</u> and/or <u>mobile app under RANKINGS</u>.

### 3. Who is on my team?

Provider members were grouped by practice geography. You should have received an email with a list of your team members, however, you can also find your team and discover who is on your team via the Whova web browser application and/or mobile app under DOCUMENTS.

### 4. I know who is in my team. What now?

Step 1. Contact your team members using Whova's mobile app or web browser application

- Add a "Social Group" in the COMMUNITY section.
- Send 1:1 and group messages in the MESSAGES section.
- Put a face to a name by creating "Virtual Meet-ups" in the COMMUNITY > "Meet-ups & Virtual Meets," for your team. Similar to a video visit, you don't need to have a Zoom account.
- Whova incorporates Zoom so you can video chat and virtually meet-up with your team. Whova tutorials are available at <u>www.hawaiihealthpartners.org</u>.
- Step 2. Choose a team leader
- Step 3. (Optional) Choose a team name email <u>Info@hawaiihealthpartners.org</u> and we'll update your team name.
- Step 4. Decide on a team goal for money raised and % participation

# 5. How to Donate Blood:

Blood donations by you, a family member, or friend will be counted towards your team's % participation.

- Step 1. Make a blood donation appointment
  - Call (808) 848-4770 to make an appointment. Tell them group code #3067 (group code needed to track team % participation)
  - Visit <u>BBH.org</u> (no group code entry available)

Step 2. When you arrive for your appointment, tell the receptionist at the front desk you are donating for *group code #3067* (group code needed to track appointments vs donations).

Forget to tell the receptionist the group code? Just email <u>Info@hawaiihealthpartners.org</u> your name and date of donation and we'll add it to your team's record.



#### 6. How to Donate Money:

In addition to donations made through Hawai'i Pacific Health's annual giving campaign, all other donations to local, community nonprofit organizations will count towards your team's total donation amount and % participation. Just send us your name and donation amount via Info@hawaiihealthpartners.org or the Whova mobile app or web browser application.

All donations from October 1<sup>st</sup> to the Hawai'i Pacific Health's annual giving campaign will be counted towards your team's total donation amount and % participation.
