

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# SHIFT TO HYBRID AGMS AS THE INDUSTRY GOLD STANDARD

**Devanesan Evanson, CEO Minority Shareholders Watch Group (MSWG) believes that hybrid AGMs remain the gold standard, according to the code of corporate governance issued by the Securities Commission, compared to physical or virtual meetings due to the flexibility it offers, allowing shareholders to attend from remote locations, and simultaneously permitting physical presence for those who are able to attend.**

Everything moved online during the pandemic, and the Annual General Meetings (AGM) of Malaysian public listed companies (PLC) were no exception. While many have resumed holding AGMs in-person, and some took on the challenge to host hybrid meetings, the virtual or online method is still being implemented.

Devanesan Evanson, CEO Minority Shareholders Watch Group (MSWG) believes that hybrid AGMs remain the gold standard, according to the code of corporate governance issued by the Securities Commission, compared to physical or virtual meetings due to the flexibility it offers, allowing shareholders to attend from remote locations, and simultaneously permitting physical presence for those who are able to attend.

“To-date, based on the PLCs monitored by MSWG, four PLCs have adopted hybrid AGMs. Sure, it costs a bit more, but you get the best of both worlds and follow the gold standard,” he told participants at the “Conducting A Better AGM” seminar organised by MSWG last week.

Many companies find hybrid AGMs a bit more costly due to the dual costs involved.

“They [PLCs] have to book a venue and prepare door gifts, food etc. At the same time, they will incur costs for an online hosting platform to enable shareholders to login for virtual attendance,” he explained.

In a hybrid model, the meetings logistics will stretch across two different platforms. Registering attendees via physical and online platforms while fielding questions from both mediums can be challenging, apart from costly.

“Logistics of handling physical questions, while questions are also coming in from the online medium could be another reason it has not gained traction yet,” he reckoned.

The head of the local shareholder activism body expressed his hopes that more PLCs will consider jumping on board hybrid AGMs as it presents the ‘best of both worlds.’

With the voting system now utilising digital devices, it facilitates online and physical votes and hastens vote count time. Devanesan also suggested that PLCs allow shareholders to cast their vote anytime during the physical AGM rather than wait for polling to start at the stipulated later time according to the agenda.

“Some shareholders are already resolute in their vote, and should not be made to sit through the AGM for the voting time to arrive before allowing them to cast their vote.

Digitalisation should make this possible,” he opined.



**PLCs should look into ways to circumvent the cost and logistic challenges and move into the hybrid AGM space.**

## **DRIVING TRANSPARENCY THROUGH BETTER AGM CONDUCT**

A key issue when it comes to fairness at AGMs according to Devanesan, is when boards provide vague and dismissive answers to questions raised by shareholders.

“This is more likely to happen at virtual AGMs where there is also a risk of virtual questions being completely ignored. Such behaviour does not encourage shareholder activism,” he said.

Devanesan also stressed that physical AGMs are good for shareholder activism as shareholders are better able to articulate

their questions using intonation and body language and there is no risk of a question being completely ignored as with a virtual AGM.

“But virtual AGMs do enable participation from remote locations, while with physical AGMs, shareholders from remote locations can still participate through the use of proxies. On a balance of benefits, the physical AGM is preferred to the virtual AGM,” he noted.

Devanesan said the second key issue at AGMs was the non-response to questions. He urged Malaysian PLCs to encourage shareholder activism and respond to all relevant questions. Facilities should be in place to allow shareholders to submit their questions related to the company’s business before the AGM to permit adequate response. Companies can also predict AGM questions for key issues and prepare their response, but Devanesan discouraged the practice of non-response or informing shareholders that their questions will be responded to later.

Thirdly, he said the company chairperson must be ‘firm yet fair’. The chairperson must be diplomatic and firm enough to dismiss

irrelevant questions by stating why it is irrelevant. Repeat questions can be addressed by stating that they have been answered and that the answers will all be posted on the corporate website.

“Shareholders prefer crisp, to the point AGMs. Not one laden with irrelevant, frivolous, and repeat questions,” he added.

The active participation and responsible actions by minority shareholders play a crucial role in motivating effective market discipline and upholding a corporate governance culture. The ASEAN Corporate Governance Scorecard, also works to uphold corporate governance culture as it assesses all PLCs on a standard set of questions along with bonus and penalty points.

The scorecard is based on the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) principles and adopted by ASEAN countries across the board. Once every two years, there is a regional assessment using the same scorecard where the top PLCs from individual participating countries are recognised and acknowledged.

“The caveat is that CG is substantially conformance – it is but one side of the coin – the other being performance. Minority shareholders must consider conformance, performance, and other factors before making their investing decisions. CG is but a means to an end and not an end in itself,” Devanesan reminded.

## **STRIVING FOR ROBUST ECOSYSTEMS**

Currently, barely 10% of the PLCs subscribe to MSWG’s scorecard subscriber services. These services enable a company to be aware of their scorecard scores and to discuss with MSWG on areas where there are opportunities for improvement. Established as a government initiative more than 20 years ago, it is a part of a broader capital market framework to protect the interests of minority shareholders through shareholder activism and an avenue for market discipline to encourage good governance amongst PLCs with the objective of raising shareholder value over time.



The benefits of subscribing to MSWG is having your organisation assessed for corporate governance compliance. The watchdog organisation also offers engagement services where it breaks down non-compliance issued towards better accountability and transparency. MSWG also attends AGMs and EGMs and provides guidance and feedback to both shareholders and organisations.

“Most PLCs are very receptive towards MSWG and even present our AGM questions and their answers through media presentations at their AGMs,” Devanesan explained.

He hopes to see more PLCs coming on board as subscribers to elevate the corporate governance landscape of listed entities in Malaysia.

“We publish the results of the CG rankings and this helps with branding, creates better perspective in the eyes of investors,” he added.

Having served at Bursa Malaysia for 18 years, Devanesan found himself intrigued by the behavioural aspects of investors - how fear and emotions impact share prices regardless of the fundamentals of a company.

“Having seen it from a regulator's perspective, it would be interesting to see it from a minority shareholder's perspective,” he said when asked of his role at MSWG.

While most PLCs rank high in transparency and disclosure, Devanesan hopes to see less ambiguous and boiler-plate responses such as ‘pursuing other interests’ or ‘not aware of reasons for unusual market activity’ when responding to Bursa Malaysia queries.

He also hoped for less negligent or reckless reporting of financial results especially material deviations between quarterly results and audited results.

Stakeholders, he noted were playing a more significant role in recent times especially in areas of sustainability, forced labour practices, workers living conditions and destructive environmental practices.

“There is a real nexus between sustainability issues and bottom-line performance and share prices. Take the example of export markets, when a Withhold Release Order (WRO) on certain products is issued or there is a boycott of some of products, you cannot export those products to foreign markets. Profits then drop and share price suffers,” he pointed out.

Devanesan said some positive changes were observed in the area of responsibilities of the board. This was due to the increased awareness of board responsibilities from training and education conducted and sanctions imposed on a personal basis on directors as opposed to on a corporate basis.

“So, increasingly, directors are doing their own due diligence when joining corporate boards and are prepared to walk away from risky board positions,” he added.

# FBM KLCI LIKELY TO HIT 1,700 NEXT YEAR – MIDF RESEARCH

**A**ccording to MIDF Research director/head of research Imran Yassin Md Yusof, the research house expects the equity market to rebound next year, with the FBM KLCI reaching 1,700 points at an implied price-earnings ratio 2023 (PER23) of 15 times. The rebound is anticipated despite economic headwinds, as pressure on valuation stemming from external factors, is expected to start dissipating. In the equities market, the FBM KLCI started the year on a positive note on the back of the reopening of the economy. Despite the unexpected eruption of the Ukraine-Russia conflict, the first quarter of 2022 saw the FBM KLCI registering a 1.3% rise. However, the aggressiveness of the US Federal Reserve (Fed) in raising its federal fund rate by 375 basis points year-to-date had caused the performance of the FBM KLCI turning negative, where it is registering a 6.1% decline as of Dec 5, 2022. He was speaking at a media briefing on the market outlook for 2023.

This impact was not confined to Malaysia's equity market only as global markets were similarly impacted or had it worse. Hence, he expects external factors such as the decision of the Fed will continue to be an influencing factor for the Malaysian equity market in 2023. In this regard, it is expected that the Fed will start to decelerate its pace of rate hikes in 2023. In general, the baseline expectation going into 2023 is that the Fed is pivoting, the risk of US recession is not insignificant, no escalation in the Russia-Ukraine war beyond the borders of Ukraine, and the authorities in China would be adept in handling its domestic economic situation (limiting the risk of cross border contagion).

The research house said the equity market would become more bullish principally due to the unwinding or subsiding pressure on required return as the upside risk diminishes with the end of the tightening cycle. The market would also be expected to tread cautiously due to the heightened risk of an impending US recession, the unsettling situation in Ukraine which could change drastically, as well as uncertainty surrounding the real situation of China's economy. As such, in 2023, the equity market is expected to be supported by a less hostile monetary environment, but equity valuation would continue to remain subpar relative to its historical range due to these limiting factors.

Besides the equity market, the aggressive Fed had led to a strong US dollar in 2022. But with the pivot by the Fed, the Ringgit is expected to move forward to average stronger at RM4.30 per US dollar and ending 2023 at RM4.23. Commodities' prices are expected to remain elevated despite normalising. The research house forecasts Brent crude oil price to average at US\$96 (RM422) per barrel and crude palm oil to average at RM3,500 per tonne.

## **EMPHASIS ON DIGITALISATION, NATION BUILDING FOR PLCS - BURSA**

Bursa Malaysia has launched the final two digital guidebooks under the Public-Listed Companies Transformation Programme, aimed at

transforming Malaysian PLCs into high-performing organisations. According to chairman Tan Sri Abdul Wahid Omar, Guidebook 4 titled "Being Digitally Enabled", focuses on the imperatives, opportunities, and benefits for businesses to become more digitally-enabled, which can lead to significant improvements in their overall performance, in line with technological advancements. Meanwhile, Guidebook 5 titled "Contributing Towards Nation Building", emphasises how the growth initiatives of businesses can fundamentally and profoundly benefit not only the companies themselves, but also directly shape the growth of the economy, community and nation.


Speaking at the launch of the PLC Transformation Programme's latest guidebooks, he said that with targeted strategies that are aligned to their respective business purpose and national agendas, PLCs can be more competitive, enhance capabilities of the workforce, and help the nation have stronger standing in global supply chains. These final two books are timely as the two-year COVID-19 pandemic has demonstrated how digitally enabled and agile businesses not only survived but thrived amid difficult times. The PLCs' earnings performance, as measured by growth in Malaysia's Index earnings per share (EPS) has been muted since the global financial crisis. Earnings fell to a 10-year low in 2020 and only began to recover last year. Similarly, Malaysia's weightage in the Morgan Stanley Capital International (MSCI) Emerging Markets Index has been generally declining since 2019, negatively impacting the ability to capture larger fractions of global funds. He noted that the weightage has recently increased to 1.62 per cent in October 2022, up from 1.39 per cent in 2021. Hence the PLCs clearly need to take deliberate and committed actions to improve their performance.

He urged all PLCs to actively participate in the PLC Transformation Programme's upcoming planned activities which span multiple years, up to 2025. To date, more than 100 PLCs have committed to participate in the PLC Transformation Programme. Bursa Malaysia launched the PLC Transformation Programme in March with the aim to steer and support Corporate Malaysia to higher performance levels by nudging actions and strengthening the growth narrative of PLCs of all sizes.

Whilst the first guidebook focused on building purpose and performance-driven organisations, the second was on sustainable, socially responsible and ethical practises and the third guidebook was on strengthening stakeholder management and investor relations.
