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AirAsia Group renames airline holding company to create clear distinction from digital business

AirAsia Group Bhd has renamed its 100%-owned subsidiary AirAsia Investment Ltd to AirAsia Aviation Ltd in a corporate reorganisation to create a clear distinction between AirAsia Group's airline and digital businesses. Bo Lingam, formerly president (airlines) for AirAsia Group, takes over as group CEO of AirAsia Aviation to oversee the group's four airlines, namely AirAsia Malaysia, AirAsia Philippines, AirAsia Thailand and AirAsia Indonesia. As AirAsia's rapid transformation from an airline into a digital travel and lifestyle services group continues to gain strong momentum, the holding company for the airline group has been officially renamed AirAsia Aviation Ltd.

According to Bo Lingam, this structural change helps facilitate strong projected growth in both airline and non-airline portfolio businesses.

Earlier in the week, AirAsia Group's group chief executive officer Tan Sri Tony Fernandes said the budget airline's digital businesses, which have a valuation of over US\$1 billion (about RM4.16 billion), have achieved unicorn status in record time at under two years since the group accelerated the growth momentum of its non-airline businesses during the Covid-19 pandemic-driven aviation sector downturn. AirAsia Group should no longer be known as just an airline.

URUS programme to assist B50 borrowers who have lost jobs, income — BNM

According to Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM) governor Datuk Nor Shamsiah Mohd Yunus, BNM welcomes the Financial Management & Resilience Programme (URUS) by Agensi Kaunseling dan Pengurusan Kredit (AKPK) and the banking industry, which seeks to aid B50 borrowers with performing loans who have lost their jobs or who are experiencing income loss of at least 50%. Eligible borrowers who wish to apply for the programme can approach their banks starting from Nov 15, 2021 to Jan 31, 2022. BNM has been working with AKPK to put in place a holistic debt management and financial planning solution. The aim is to provide appropriate support to borrowers so that they not only meet their loan obligations but importantly, return to a firmer financial footing. This will strengthen the financial resilience of borrowers in the longer term. The central bank also encouraged those that are not eligible for URUS to also approach their banks to discuss other repayment solutions that suit their financial circumstances. Borrowers and customers facing any difficulty with their applications may contact BNM TELELINK at bnm.my/RAsurvey to seek assistance, and that they may obtain more information on the new scheme by visiting banks' and AKPK's websites. There will be further enhancements to BNM's Fund for SMEs in the Budget 2022, targeted at assisting businesses in their cash flow management and reposition themselves with the reopening of the economy. Despite heightened credit risks, bank financing to SMEs continues to expand with the additional


capacity provided through the fund and credit guarantee schemes. A total of RM154 billion was disbursed to SMEs, 4% higher than the pre-pandemic level, with a total of RM18 billion allocated under the fund to augment financing by the banking system to SMEs. Loans outstanding for the SME segment increased 6% year-on-year, and efforts are underway to develop debt equity and blended financing initiatives to enable SMEs access to a wider range of appropriate financing options across their growth cycle. This will be important to lower the leverage and strengthen the long-term resilience and capacity of SMEs, and increase their contribution to the economy.

Maybank IB retains 'positive' call on regional plantations

According to Maybank Investment Bank (Maybank IB) Research, it has maintained its "positive" call on the regional plantation sector based on expectations of crude palm oil (CPO) prices staying relatively lofty until the first quarter of 2022 (1Q22). CPO prices were expected to remain lofty on supply concerns although it may not sustain at RM5,000 per tonne. Near-term CPO price may continue to be supported by the fact that palm oil output will enter into a seasonal low yield period in 1Q22. According to the Malaysian Palm Oil Board, September 2021 stockpile fell 7% month-on-month to 1.75 million tonnes below street estimates of 1.87 million tonnes. The recent CPO price rally to above RM5,000 per tonne (spot month) has further narrowed CPO price discounts. It maintain the view that the current high CPO price is not sustainable as a wider discount is needed to sustain demand. India's demand for vegetable oils will likely weaken post Deepavali. In 4Q21, the market will closely monitor ongoing South America planting season of crops for new price direction. The market is expecting record planting and harvest at this juncture. A confirmation and potential impact of La Nina on South America crop development till its harvest in March and April 2022 will be a key swing factor to watch in the coming months.

Eye On The Markets

This week, on Friday (15Oct), the Ringgit opened at 4.1565 against the USD from 4.1665 on Monday (11Oct). Meanwhile, the Ringgit was 3.0827 to the Sing Dollar on Friday (15Oct). On Monday (11Oct), the FBM KLCI opened at 1567.88. As at Friday (15Oct) 10:00am, the FBM KLCI is up 26.07 points for the week at 1593.95. Over in US, the overnight Dow Jones Industrial Average closed up 534.75 points (+1.56%) to 34,912.56 whilst the NASDAQ added 251.80 points (+1.73%) to 14,823.40.

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Deep Dive into a Major Low-Cost Coal Producer in Indonesia

Corporate Profile



Geo Energy Resources Limited (Geo Energy) is a major Indonesian coal producer with an established track record in operating coal mines, coal production and selling coal throughout the region. Geo Energy commenced its business in 2008 as a coal mining services provider and has since transitioned to a coal producer that subcontracts its coal mining operations.

The transition allowed the Group to change the business model from operating as a relatively small-scale mining services provider in an environment of high capital expenditure and relatively low operational efficiency, with high dependence on owners of coal mining concessions, to being a low-cost coal producer with high-quality coal mining assets.

Technical Analysis



Based on the weekly chart, after enduring a period of consolidation in October 2020, it managed to stage a strong breakout in November 2020. This can be seen from the surge in buying activities as seen from the volume bar chart, as well as the various candlesticks which are trading above the upper limit of the Bollinger Band.

Subsequently, its share price underwent a minor correction, accompanied by low trading volume. This indicates that the price action is purely being affected by those investors who wish to take profit from the counter.


After breaching the 20 Day Moving Average line briefly in March 2021, its share price returned to an uptrend and has since not breached the 20 Day Moving Average line. This shows that the counter is very bullish.

Another indication of the positive sentiment would be its MACD line. It has been trading above zero since November 2020 till now. Coupled with its Relative Strength Index (RSI) trading near the overbought territory, this shows that Geo Energy's share price is experiencing a strong uptrend momentum.

Despite the bullish sentiment, investors will have to take notice of any potential

profit taking as its share price is trading above the upper limit of the Bollinger Band.

For FY2020, its revenue (blue bar) grew by 21.15% year-on-year to S\$406.48 million. The rise was contributed by the higher sales volume, while partially offset by the lower Average Selling Price (ASP) in FY2020 caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. On that note, ASP was US\$27.89 per tonne in 2020 as compared to US\$33.67 in 2019.

Meanwhile, they managed to be back in the black, with a profit after tax of S\$126.08 million, as compared to a loss of S\$64.28 million a year earlier. The turnaround was mainly driven by lower production costs, and the gain on the Group's repurchases of its Notes.

For its trailing 12-month financial performance, Geo Energy's revenue grew by 17.23% to S\$476.52 million. The higher revenue was boosted by both the increase in sales volume and ASP.

Despite the topline growth, its profit after tax declined by 22.48% to S\$97.73 million, on back of absence of gains from the repurchases of Senior Notes.

Conclusion & Management Outlook

Geo Energy's financial performance has improved significantly, all thanks to the sharp rise in coal prices and sales volume of coal. On top of that, analysts' consensus estimate also indicates that they are bullish on its prospects.

In terms of management outlook, Geo Energy expects a strong performance for 2H FY2021, given the trend of higher coal prices and an increase in production volume. The increase of 1.5 million tonnes RKAB production quota at the current coal price of US\$81.40 per tonne potentially adds US\$122 million to the Group's revenue for FY2021.


Finally, Geo Energy is looking to expand its revenue streams by way of potential joint ventures, trading and value accretive acquisitions, including mining concessions to increase production quantity and diversify into renewables supply chain, and downstream logistics and transshipments.

It is not transitory

Markets

The International Monetary Fund (IMF), in its quarterly review of the global economy, has lowered its global GDP growth for this year by 0.1 percentage points to 5.9% and left its forecast unchanged for 2022 at 4.9%. For the US, the IMF reduced its estimate by a full percent to 6% from 7% previously. IMF lowered its assessment after supply disruptions and higher inflationary pressure was seen taking its toll on the global economy while worsening pandemic in selected regions too has impacted its projections.

Meanwhile, minutes of the Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) showed that the Fed is ready to begin tapering its monthly US\$120bil bond-buying program as early as the middle of next month or mid-December, mainly on concerns that inflation may not be as transitory as earlier thought, judging by the recent rally in energy prices and selected commodities.

Chinese authorities are said to begin inspecting the nation's financial regulators, biggest state-run banks, insurers, and bad debt managers for the first time in six years to root out corruption in its \$54 trillion financial system. According to a Bloomberg report, a team led by the Central Commission for Discipline Inspection will start a two-month anti-graft check of the China Banking and Insurance Regulatory Commission, and accept complaint reports from whistle-blowers until mid-December 2021.

Economy

Last Friday, the US September Non-Farm Payrolls came in well below expectations with just 194k jobs added against a forecast of 488k. Nevertheless, the unemployment rate fell to 4.8% from an estimate of 5.1%. This week, major economic data out of the US was the headline and core inflation figures for September, which came in at 5.4% and 4% respectively. The headline number was slightly ahead of market expectations of a 5.3% rise.

Meanwhile, Chinese external trade data for September were mixed as exports surged 28.1% y-o-y, well above the market forecast of a 21.5% gain, but imports growth was slower than the consensus estimate of a 20.9% increase, coming in with a growth of just 17.6% y-o-y. As a result, trade surplus widened to US\$66.8bil from the preceding month's total of US\$58.3bil. In other news, the September Producer Price Index (PPI) jumped 10.7% y-o-y, but the Consumer Price Index (CPI) remained subdued at just 0.7% y-o-y.

South Korea left benchmark rates unchanged at 0.75%, signalled that it may raise rates as soon as next month following persistent inflation and rising household debts. Down south, Singapore released advanced estimates for its 3Q GDP which showed the city-state's economy expanded by 6.5% y-o-y and much slower than the preceding quarter's growth of 15.2% y-o-y. In related news, Singapore unexpectedly tightened its monetary policy for the first time in three years on the back of mounting cost pressures caused by supply constraints and a recovery in the global economy.

Locally, the August labour market statistics showed Malaysia's unemployment rate improved to 4.6% from 4.8% in the preceding month. For the month, the number of employed persons increased by almost 81,800 while unemployed

persons declined by 29,400. From the plantation sector, the September 2021 monthly stock level released by the Malaysian Palm Oil Board (MPOB) showed stock level fell by 7% m-o-m to 1.747 million metric tonnes while output for the month dropped 8.9% y-o-y to 1.704 million metric tonnes.

In other economic data points, Malaysia's Wholesale & Retail trade registered total sales of RM100bil, down 10.2% y-o-y, although when compared with the preceding month, sales rose by 7.9%. All three sub-industries reported contraction for August as Wholesale Trade, Retail Trade and Motor Vehicle fell by 0.1%, 7.5%, and 57.6% y-o-y to RM51.9bil, RM42.3bil, and RM5.8bil respectively. On the other hand, data from the manufacturing sector showed sales expanded by 6.8% y-o-y and 5.5% m-o-m to register RM126.5bil in August. Significant gains were registered by the Petrochemical, Chemical, Rubber and Plastic Products segment, which saw sales value rising by 31.4% y-o-y, followed by a 7.0% rise in Food, Beverage and Tobacco Products segment and a 6.9% increase in Electrical and Electronics Products. However, Malaysia's Industrial Production Index (IPI) for August declined by 0.7% y-o-y as growth in the manufacturing segment of 0.6% y-o-y was offset by a 4.2% and 4.8% drop in the Mining and Electricity component respectively.

Meanwhile, the lower house of the Parliament has passed the second reading of the government's move to raise the country's debt to GDP ratio from 60% to 65% as well as to increase the allocation under the Covid-19 Fund to RM110bil from RM65bil approved previously. According to the Finance Minister, the higher debt ceiling is a temporary measure and will be in effect only up to Dec 31, 2022. The debt-to-GDP ratio will revert to the original 60% thereafter.

In other news, the government is expected to set up a Financial Management and Resilience Programme (URUS), which is targeted towards helping out eligible borrowers in the B50 group. This includes interest rates exemptions for up to 3 months, reduction in instalments for up to 24 months, and lower interest rates. The banking institutions are expected to set aside RM1bil for the cost of interest and profit waivers or reductions under the programme.

Corporate

With the increase in global energy prices, Gas Malaysia too has raised its average natural gas selling price to RM36.42 per million British Thermal Units (MMBtu) effective Oct 1, 2021, and up to the end of the 4Q period. The increase is 21.3% from the preceding quarter's average price of RM30.03 per MMBtu.

In corporate moves, Lion Industries Corporation (LICB) announced that its 99% owned subsidiary, Amsteel Mills Sdn. Bhd. has agreed to dispose of a 100% stake in Antara Steel Mills Sdn. Bhd. and extra assets to Esteel Enterprise Pte. Ltd. for US\$158.82mil or RM663.8mil. LICB will recognize a gain of RM403.1mil from the sale or 51 sen per share.

Genting Malaysia (GENM) was also in the news this week with the announcement that it will make another US\$150mil or RM625mil investment in its US-owned Empire Resorts Ltd for the latter to make repayment of its short-term debts. With the additional investment,

GENM's total investment in the company now stands at US\$524.4mil or RM2.19bil.

In contract news, Kerjaya Prospek Group has been awarded the contract for the main building works for a proposed residential development of three blocks of apartment located at Kampong Bendahara, Mukim Plentong, Johor for RM258mil.

Meanwhile, the Securities Commission has reprimanded China Automobile Parts Holdings as well as its current and former directors and chief financial officers for various breaches in the company's prospectus for its initial public offering (IPO), which contained financial statements that were false or misleading.

Equity

World equity markets were mostly firmer this week as investors brushed aside selected weak economic data and rising commodity prices and focus on the positive economic data points and a clear path towards the Fed's tapering move. Other than a 0.1% decline on the Dow Jones Industrial Average, a 0.3% drop in the Shanghai Composite Index, and a 2% fall in the Taiwan Stock Exchange Weighted Index, all other bourses were firmer for the week with gains of between 0.1% and 3.3%. Locally, the KLCI closed another 31.23 points or 2% higher at 1,592.52 as buying interest spread to the broader market and in particular selected banking, oil and gas, and plantation companies.

For the week ended Oct 13th, foreigners turned net buyers with an inflow of RM793.6mil, while local institutions were at the other end of the stick, maintaining their net selling position with an outflow of RM795mil. That left the retail net buying interest for the past five market days at just RM1.4mil.

Eye on Week Ahead


Later today, the key data out of the US will be the US Sept retail sales, which is expected to increase by 0.4% y-o-y, while the preliminary October University of Michigan Consumer Sentiment indicator is forecasted to show an improved reading of 74.0 against 72.8 in the preceding month.

On Monday, Oct 18, China will be announcing its 3Q GDP data with the market expecting the world's second-largest economy to expand by 5.2% y-o-y. In conjunction with the GDP data, China will also release key September economic data on Fixed Asset Investment, Industrial Production, and Retail Sales.

The following day, all eyes will again be on the US housing market as data on September Building Permits and Housing Starts will be out, with consensus expecting an annualized rate of 1.72mil and 1.63mil respectively. On Wednesday Oct 20, the market's attention will shift to the Fed as their assessment of the state of the US economy with the release of the Beige Book. On the same day, the People's Bank of China is expected to decide on interest rates. On Oct 20, attention is expected to shift towards Europe as the IHS Markit's Manufacturing Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) and Composite PMI preliminary data for October will be out.

Locally, the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) will be releasing the August rubber statistics data.

Auditors must be more upfront on reason/s behind their voluntary resignation

The resignation of Lysaght Galvanized Steel Bhd's external auditor Ernst & Young PLT (EY) merely two days after being reappointed at the Company's 42nd annual general meeting (AGM) on 27 September has raised eyebrows given there was no apparent reason that could have prompted the latter to step down. Minority shareholders are left wondering what could have transpired to warrant the short two-day tenure of the external auditor. The appointment of EY as the auditor for Lysaght was approved by shareholders during the AGM with 74.7% approval rate. As such, the tenure of EY as an external auditor of Lysaght was expected to be until financial year ending 31 December 2021. However, in a stock exchange filing dated 1 October, Lysaght noted that it had received a notice in writing from EY expressing its decision to resign effective 29 September pursuant to Section 281(1) of the Companies Act (CA) 2016.

Section 281(1) of CA 2016 states that an auditor may resign by providing a notice of resignation to the company at its registered office. By so doing, the auditor's term of office shall come to an end after 21 days from the submission of the notice or from the date specified in the notice. "The resignation of EY is on a voluntary basis," Lysaght said. "The board is not aware of any matter that needs to be brought to the attention of the shareholders of the company." Lysaght further noted that it will appoint another audit firm as the company's new auditors and will make an immediate announcement upon the finalisation of the appointment.

Be upfront

While it is not wrong for EY to voluntarily

resign as Lysaght's auditors, one wonders why the former sought re-appointment in the first place. Given there is no element of wrongdoing involved, the external auditor should be more upfront on the reasons behind their resignation rather than making investors/shareholders second-guess or speculate on the reasons for the resignation. Surely, external auditors owe a moral duty to the shareholders who appoint them to state their reasons for resignation.

Scouting for other incidences of auditors' resignation, Pimpinan Ehsan Bhd announced on 3 June that its auditor BDO PLT has voluntarily resigned and that the group has recommended the appointment of Crowe Malaysia PLT as its new auditor. In its Bursa Malaysia filing, Pimpinan Ehsan said BDO which was re-appointed as its auditors in the previous extraordinary general meeting (EGM) held in June 2020 was slated to hold office until the conclusion of the company's next AGM of in 2021. "Save for the above, the board is not aware of any matters that need to be brought to the attention of the shareholders of the company," added Pimpinan Ehsan.

However, in another similar event, poultry and egg producer Lay Hong Bhd stated the reason as to why its former auditor Ong Boon Bah & Co (OBB & Co) voluntarily resigned as auditor of the company on 27 November 2019. In a Bursa Malaysia filing, Lay Hong said the resignation of OBB & Co was solely due to the firm's intention to withdraw its registration with the Audit Oversight Board (AOB) and not any other reason. As such, OBB & Co was no longer eligible to be appointed as external auditor of public listed companies (PLCs). Likewise, Yong Tai Bhd was also very upfront

about the resignation of its auditor Ecovis Malaysia PLT who resigned on 4 June 2019 as the group intended to appoint another auditor. "Ecovis who had been the auditors of the company were re-appointed at the last AGM of the company held on 22 November 2018 to hold office until the conclusion of the next AGM of the company. The resignation is on a voluntary basis as the company wishes to appoint another auditor" explained Yong Tai.

Inferences when external auditors resign mid-tenure

Minority shareholders generally infer that all may not be well when external auditors resign during the mid of their tenure – especially when no reasons are given for such resignations by the company or the external auditors. Very often we get boilerplate reasons given by the company that the external auditor resigned voluntarily. Almost, always the external auditor does not state the reasons for their resignation. There were a few reasons given in the past which stated that the resignation was due to manpower constraints by external auditors, but this reason is puzzling as surely one of the criteria to be registered with AOB is to have adequate manpower.

Given the role played by external auditors as gatekeepers in the corporate governance ecosystem, it is legitimate to expect the actual reasons for the resignation of external auditors from the company – or at least from the external auditor. After all shareholders appointed you, should you not give a reason if you choose to resign?

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SHARIAH HOT STOCKS
