Located in the roundabout off of Moanalua Rd.

Located at the back of the hospital under the large white tent.

- Patients interested in testing <u>must</u> contact their physician to obtain an order. Appointments are required at Kapi'olani and Pali Momi. Screenings at Wilcox are on a first-come, firstserved basis.
- Appointments can be scheduled through Clinical Labs of Hawaii online at ClinicalLabs.com/COVID.
- If the physician does not have access to a fax or EPIC to place an order, the physician may call Clinical Labs directly at 808-677-7998 and place a verbal order for a COVID-19 test. Physician should indicate which drive-up location the patient will visit and if the patient is a healthcare worker or first responder.
- When the patient arrives to the specimen collection site, staff can verify the order by calling the Clinical Lab location at their site:

- Physician orders test: SARs-CoV-2.
- Patient must present the following items to be reviewed at the specimen collection sites:
  - Appointment confirmation number (for Kapi'olani and Pali Momi only)
  - Valid photo ID (Driver's license, State ID or Passport)
  - Physician's test order (via patient-delivered order, faxed lab requisition form, verbal order, or EPIC entered)
  - Insurance card, if applicable (Clinical Labs of Hawaii will handle billing directly, patient/normal copay may apply)
- Nasal swab will be obtained at specimen collection site.
- Ordering physician will receive test results.
- Ordering physician is responsible for ensuring that positive results are reported to the Hawai'i Department of Health <u>and</u> patient is notified of results.
